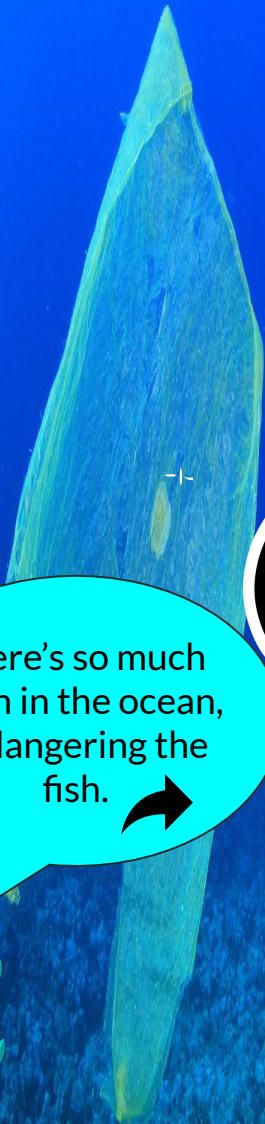
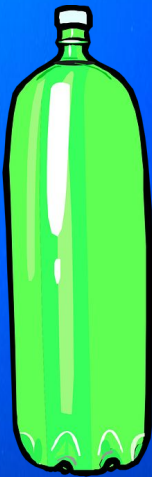


I love to swim and

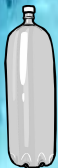

Did you know that
some of the trash

Recycling turns used waste, or trash, into new materials. Paper, plastic, glass, and metal are recyclable.



Did you know your shoes could be made from recycled materials? Some brands use recycled water bottles to make their shoes!



The same goes for bags, benches, jewelry, and even clothes! Even tires can be recycled. Unfortunately, not enough people recycle.



Often, people throw away these materials. Then, that trash gets thrown into the ocean and left to float around.
